

## **Biography for Edward Choke**

Associate Professor Edward Choke is presently a Consultant Vascular and Endovascular Surgeon at Sengkang General Hospital, Singapore. Prior to this, he trained in Oxford and Leicester, leading to appointment as a consultant at Leicester Royal Infirmary, UK.

He was previously the principal investigator of research grants from the British Heart Foundation, Wellcome Trust, Academy of Medical Sciences and Circulation Foundation (George Davies Visionary Award). He has over 100 publications in peer reviewed international journals including high impact journals such as Circulation, ATVB, EJVES and the British Journal of Surgery. He has written 5 book chapters in vascular surgery. He currently serves as an Editorial Board member of the European Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery.

One of his specialist interest is diabetic limb salvage and he regularly runs international workshops to teach other doctors on how to save legs from complications of diabetes. He is currently the Principal Investigator of the XTOSI Trial on the first in-human study of the clinical use and safety of sirolimus drug coated balloons in peripheral arterial disease.
